Use only outdoors or with adequate ventilation.

## 4 – FIRST-AID MEASURES

## 6 – ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

**SPILL PROCEDURES:** ..... Dike to prevent spillage into streams or sewer systems. Consult local, state and federal authorities.

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## 7 – HANDLING and STORAGE

**STORAGE:** .....Store in a cool, well-ventilated area. Avoid overheating or freezing. Keep container tightly closed and locked up when not in use. Do NOT store this product in an unmarked container.

**HANDLING:** .....Maintain adequate ventilation of work area. Wear eye, face and skin protection. Avoid breathing product mist and spray. Do NOT transfer this product to an unmarked container.
